- Regular upkeep and maintenance was performed.
- We did more of dead end flushing. We mix the flushing up into 2 parts NORTH & SOUTH. We do the every other week and on the off week we run different dead ends lite.
- I did a meter read.
- The County help install a flushing pipe on RT64 so we will have a good place & safe place to flush the last hydrant
- Eye wash and Fire Extinguishers checks have been done.
- We did our monthly water sample required by the D.O.H. MET the bacteriological requirements for a public water supply as set forth in subpart 5-1.5 of the State Sanitary Code under Public Heath Law 225.
- All fire hydrants are in service.
- We did our Nitrate, Lead and Copper, Secondary Inorganic Chemicals, Principle Organic Chemicals. I would like to thank the home owners that were willing to do the lead and copper tests for me. I'm still waiting on the Lead and Copper test to come back, ALL others have came back and are good. If anyone would like to see them the results are in the water office.
- On the 14th of August I will be meeting with Kevin Maine, Program Specialist from New York Rural Water Allocations to have him look over the Water office to see if he can find any energy saving. This will be a free service.
