## SPECIAL MEETING-SALEM TOWN BOARD FIRST 2023 BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING SEPTEMBER 21, 2022

**5:15 pm**-Meeting called to order by Supervisor Clary, followed by Pledge of Allegiance

**Trial Balances**-Provided thru August 31, 2022

**2023 Budget**-Supervisor Clary advised the Board that she had plugged in a 10% salary increase across the board, which would amount to an approximate \$13,000 budget increase. (Travis Keys, H'Way. Sup't., has requested a \$6,000 salary increase, not including benefits.) Cost of inflation is now at 7.5%. Discussion among Board members; some uncomfortable w/that much of an increase w/the tough times the town is facing & the fact that Salem & Shushan Fire Dep'ts. & Salem Rescue Squad would not receive the same increase. No actual budget presented as not all figures were available to plug into the proper line items.

No Justice figures; no figures on buildings

Library has requested increase from \$32,000 to \$34,000

Jean McLenithan, as Assessor, will stay the same.

Attorney is staying the same @ \$7,500

FYI-Travis sent an email from his meeting stating that even @ \$23/hour, Towns are not able to hire or keep help.

<u>Printer Issues-Clerk to Supervisor</u>-Kathy has been having constant issues w/printing; she prints a few sheets & has to shut down the system & start over. She will ask Joe Wever & Mark Rode to take a look at her system issues to see if there is any fixing to it.

<u>Motion made by</u> Councilman Howard Law, seconded by Councilwoman Laura Dunham, to move forward with the purchase of a new printer for Clerk to Supervisor Chambers if Joe Wever & Mark Rode determine the issues cannot be fixed; passed unanimously 5-0.

Supervisor Clary & Clerk to Supervisor Chambers will work on plugging in figures on the appropriate line items in the 2023 Budget for the next meeting.

<u>Motion to Adjourn</u>-Motion made by Councilwoman Laura Dunham, seconded by Councilman Marcus Blanck, to adjourn the 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 Budget Workshop meeting of the Salem Town Board; passed unanimously 5-0; meeting adjourned at 5:55 pm.
